

## 2016 Con†Stellation XXXIV: Mensa Art Show Report

Dear Artist:

Thanks for participating in the *2016 Con†Stellation XXXIV: Mensa Art Show*. The total membership for the convention this year, which ran from October 14<sup>th</sup> to October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016, was about 130. ### STATISTICS:

This art show consisted of 465 pieces (including prints but not 25 donated charity pieces) from 14 artists, displayed on 22 panels and 6 tables. The mail-in participation was from 8 artists. The print shop had 3 artists participating. There were 68 pieces sold for a total of \$1910.00 (not including \$435 raised for the Huntsville Madison Country Library). Thus, for non-charity items, the average sales price was \$29.09 per piece. The average total sales per selling artist was about \$146.92. The most sales for a single artist was \$1036 and the lowest was no sales. We had 30 pieces that went to the Saturday voice auction.
